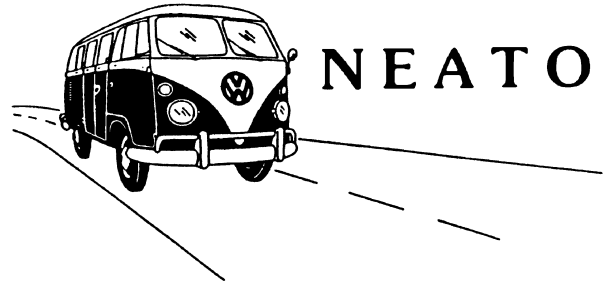

Join us for a relaxed pre-Transporterfest camp-out starting Friday Sept. 26 at 5pm until Sunday morning. "Safari-style" field camping with nearby flush toilet facilities (no showers) and plenty of picnic tables. Other activities available at the YMCA camp include: basketball, tennis, street hockey, soccer, hiking, biking, playground, wooded campfire ring. It is also just a short drive or bike ride (about 1 mile or less) to the Ashland State Park where there is a lake and a swimming beach. Since it is a YMCA camp there is no alcohol or smoking permitted on the grounds. However, I anticipate that we may be "self-policing" our own evening activities. On Sunday there will be an early morning (8 am) caravan to the show at the Museum of Transportation in Brookline. There may also be a later caravan to the show. The show is approximately 30-45 minutes from the campground.

Directions to Campground:

From points North and Northwest:

Take I-495 to exit 23, route 9 east
Continue east on route 9 for approx. 2 miles
Follow signs for route 85 south
>Follow directions below from route 85 south

From Boston and points East and Northeast:

Take MA turnpike (I-90) west to exit 12, route 9 west
Continue west on route 9 for approx. 2 miles
Follow signs for route 85 south, right lane to cross-over route 9

>Continue south on route 85 for approx. 4 miles
Turn left at light onto route 135 east
Continue east on 135 for approx. 2 miles
Turn right onto Clinton St. (look for stone pillar on right)
Continue on Clinton St. for approx. 1 mile (residential/rural area)
Turn left onto East St., camp is on left, approx. 1/4 mile

From points South:

Take I-495 to exit 20, route 85 north
Continue north on route 85 for approx. 4 miles
Turn right at light onto route 135 east
Continue east on 135 for approx 2 miles
Turn right onto Clinton St. (look for stone pillar on right)
Continue on Clinton St. for approx. 1 mile (residential/rural area)
Turn left onto East St., camp is on left, approx. 1/4 mile
