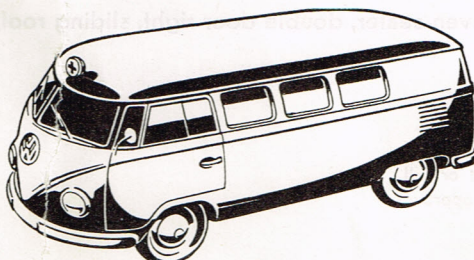

### ***in the supply of spare parts please note:***

- ① Use the appropriate blanks for the preparation of your orders.
- ② Enumerate the items required in parts list sequence with the exception of standard parts and SP-sets which should be shown in numerical sequence at the end of the order.
- ③ Prepare orders typewritten only.
- ④ In case of doubt always indicate:  
**Engine and Chassis Nos**
- ⑤ Forward sample or sketch showing measurements in case of parts not listed in parts list.
- ⑥ When ordering seats and/or trimmings indicate designation of material and color. In case of doubt attach sample of the material.
- ⑦ Samples, which should be forwarded free of charge, are to be labeled indicating:
  - a) Sender's address
  - b) Reference of the order
  - c) Engine and Chassis Nos.
- ⑧ In case of orders by telephone correct supply cannot be guaranteed.
- ⑨ Designations such as front – rear – left – right are determined from the driving seat facing forward.

**Type No.**

**Chassis No.:**

Up to chassis No. 20 - 117 901 on identity plate affixed to partition in engine compartment,

from chassis No. 20 - 117 902 onward, above identity plate affixed to partition in engine compartment.

**Engine No.:**

On generator support below inscription "Zündfolge 1-4-3-2".

**Transmission and Rear Axle No:**

On right-hand transmission case half behind the gearshift housing.

**Front Axle No.:**

On right-hand suspension arm stop.



## Introduction

This spare parts list supersedes all previous issues. It includes all amendments until the date of publication of this list. Any further amendments will be covered by the monthly information sheets.

All spare parts itemized in this list are broken down into 10 main groups which correspond to the main units of the vehicle. Each main unit consists of several sub groups, the number of which varies according to the size and design of the unit.

Within the main and/or sub groups the spare parts are listed and numbered in their constructional order. The illustrations have been grouped accordingly.

Each spare parts number consists of nine figures. The first 3 figures designate the type and model. The next figure shows the main group. The following two figures indicate the sub group. The last three figures represent the actual numerical designation of the part. In case of modifications of material or design a letter is added to the spare parts number of those parts not substituting the relevant earlier parts. The alphabetical order indicates the number of modifications made.

### Example:

The crankcase part number is: 111 101 025 A

It is pointed out that designations such as front-rear-left-right are determined from the driving seat, facing forward. If a spare part is available in left- and right-hand version, the odd end figure usually designates the left type part and the following even end figure the right one.
